

ACTIVITY PERIOD OVERVIEW

What is activity period?

- The goals of activity period are:
 - Provide opportunities for students to seek and ask for help from teachers
 - Allow time for meetings that does not interfere with classes
 - Assist students to improve grades in classes

What Activity Period is Not:

- Social time
- Time to be on phones
- Time to be on computers for non-academic purposes

When is activity period?

- Activity period will meet from 3:10-3:30.
- Students on work release in grades 11-12 will be able to leave IF not on the low grade report.
- 9-12 grade students in athletics will be able to leave for practices IF not on the low grade report and practice is meeting during this time.

Where do I go?

- All students will be assigned to a teacher's classroom.
- This is a different group than your normal advisory assignments.
- Attendance will be taken daily.
- To work with another teacher, that other teacher must contact your activity period teacher before 8th period each day.

Where do I go?

- Students eligible for practices must check-in prior to going to practice.
- Work release students may check out of the office as usual.
- Students in jazz band or troubadours will still have Tuesday/Thursday afternoon practices.

What do I do?

- Everyone is expected to work during activity period on school work.
- No breaks will be allowed.
- If you are done for the day, bring a book to read.
- If you don't have things to do, you will be asked to complete other items or assist other students needing help.
- Those not using time effectively are subject to disciplinary action including detention.

Testing Tuesdays

- We're ready to take the ISASP test. We will take these tests on Tuesdays starting on the 12th.
- We will take one test each of the following days:
 - Tuesday, March 12th—Reading
 - Tuesday, March 19th—Science (Grades 8 and 10 only)
 - Tuesday, March 26th—Math
 - Tuesday, April 2nd—Writing

Testing Tuesdays

- On the 12th and 26th, we will run a liturgy schedule and test from 10 to 11:15 in advisories.
- On the 19th, 8th and 10th graders will test during 3rd period class.
- On the 2nd, we will run on a 2 hour delay schedule for classes but start the day with the writing test in advisories.
