A Message from the Principal

Greetings from Beckman Catholic! It is my pleasure to share with you this annual report, highlighting many of the successes we have had in the past year. This success is due in large part to your continued support in so many varied ways.

At Beckman Catholic we continue to engage in a variety of programs and initiatives to improve and enhance the student experience. In the past year, we have upgraded our lighting throughout the building and in our parking lots to LED fixtures and bulbs. Not only has this improved areas, but it should also lead to lower energy costs in the future. Over the past summer, our Booster Club and Music Parents Association, along with many area businesses, constructed a new patio and expanded the restroom facilities at our outdoor stadium. We've been able to enjoy this new addition to the facility during the football season and look forward to many additional uses for this new space. By the end of the calendar year, we will have completed our auditorium light project, putting in new stage lighting for plays, musicals, concerts, and weekly masses. Our building and grounds committee continues to work on identifying additional short and long-term items in need of upgrades, such as replacement of doors for the gymnasium area, football field turf and track resurfacing.

We are also working to improve our academic offerings. This year we've added additional college credit courses through a new collaboration with St. Louis University. The 1818 program from St. Louis University also has potential benefits for our faculty, allowing them to work on additional coursework to improve their professional practice.

Beckman Catholic, along with Xavier Elementary, is also in the beginning stages of a four-year strategic planning process with the Archdiocese of Dubuque and Catholic School Management, a national firm who assists Catholic schools across the United States with these efforts. During this process, we will be reviewing our mission and vision, developing strategic initiatives, creating new communications and marketing plans, and strengthening our development programs. We have a firm foundation to build upon at Beckman Catholic due to the efforts so many of you have made and continue to make. This process should be one to help us go from "great to greater."

All of these efforts would not be possible without your continued support. This report highlights the generosity of so many individuals who make Catholic education possible in our area. We are extremely grateful for these gifts, as well as the gifts of time, talents, and prayers we receive. On behalf of the administration, faculty, students, and families of Beckman Catholic, thank you for all that you do to help us continue to make Catholic education a reality.

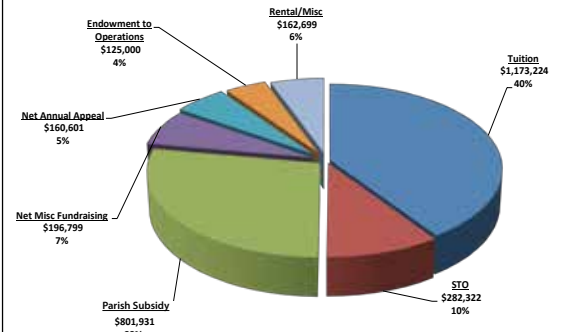

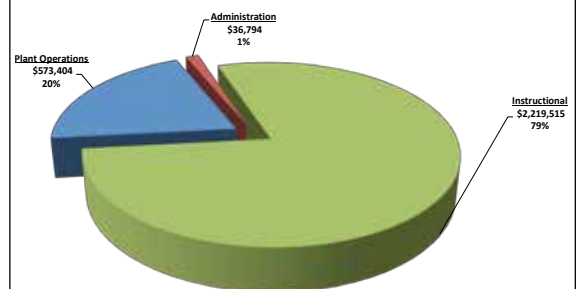

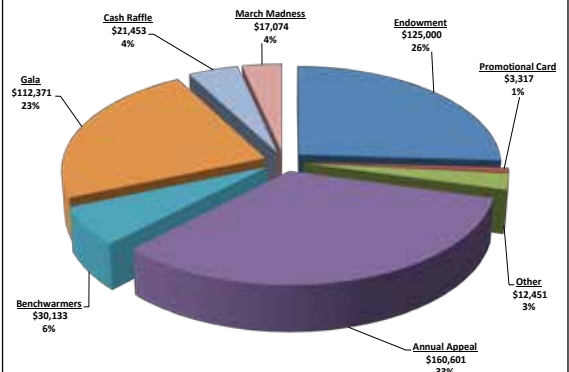
REVENUE SOURCES

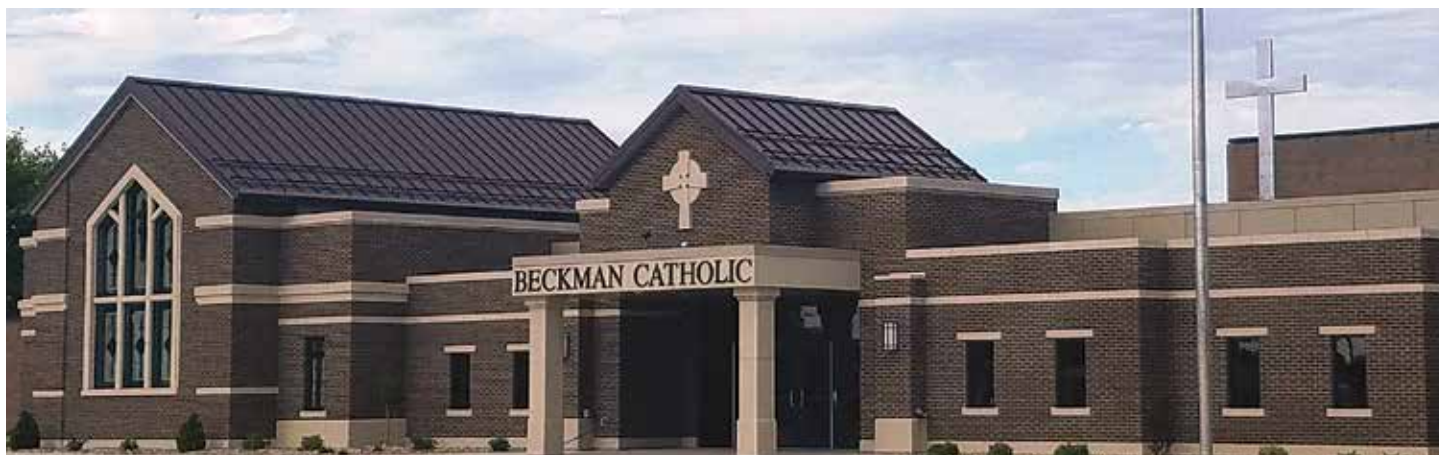


OPERATING EXPENSES

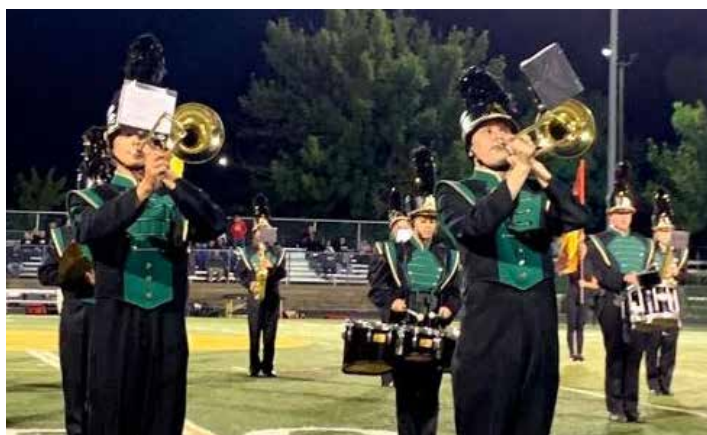

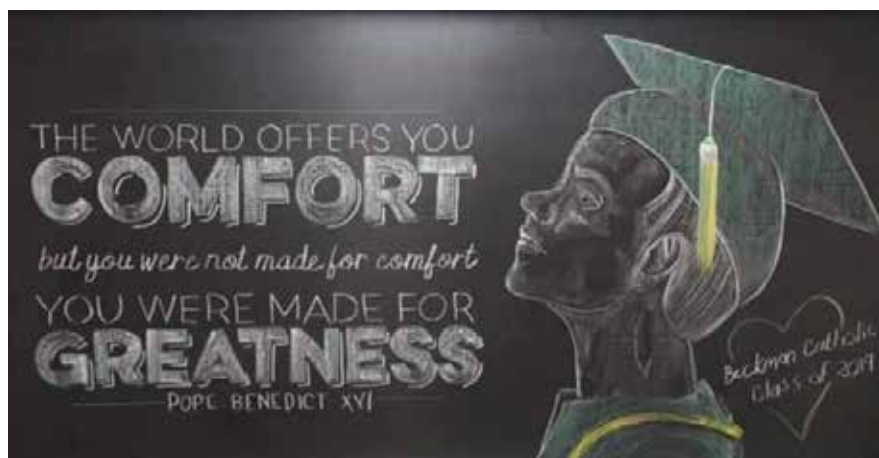

Evan Schlarmann Selected for GYI 2019 (BCHS class of 2020)



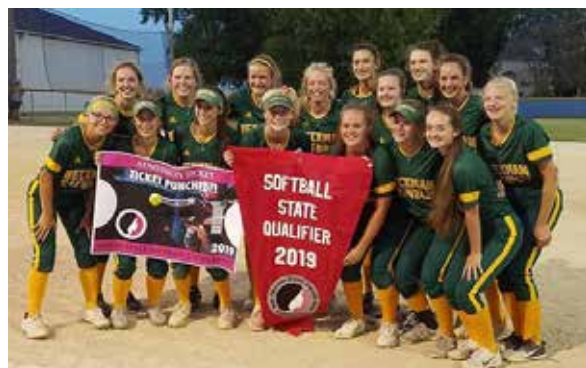
Each year, 200 exceptional high school students from around the world are selected to participate in the three-day Global Youth Institute hosted by the World Food Prize Foundation.

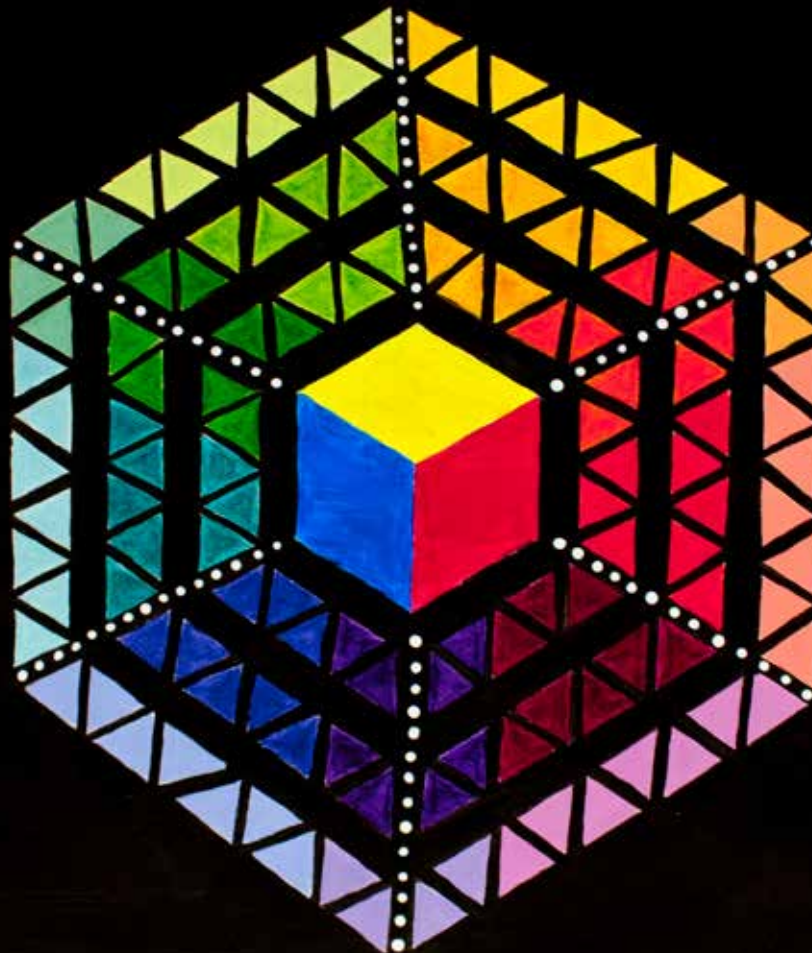
