A Message from the Principal

Greetings from Beckman Catholic! It is my pleasure to share with you this annual report, highlighting many of the successes we have had in the past year. This definitely has been a year of challenges but thanks to your prayers and continued support we continue to persevere through the adversity. This would not be possible without your continued support in so many varied ways.

When COVID-19 required us to suspend in-person learning in March of 2020, our staff pivoted and within a week we began having educational programming for students. We began with a C-Term, consisting of a variety of courses based on teacher interest ranging from criminal masterminds to cooking to dog obedience. This allowed our staff to get comfortable with online learning tools and formats. When at-home learning became long-term, our staff used what they had learned from our initial foray into remote learning and completed our 4th quarter with students learning online. As we've worked through the current school year, our staff has been working with students both in-person as well as students at home. We've utilized a variety of technologies to make this happen. Being a 1:1 school with Chromebooks in the hands of every student has been key to allowing learning both in-person and remotely to be successful. Our goal is to continue to provide academic excellence to our students and families.

Students also have numerous opportunities to pursue physical excellence both in and out of the classroom. Our sports teams continue to excel, as our football team and volleyball team had playoff runs this year and we had our first ever top 10 cross country finisher. Inside and outside of the classroom, students benefit from our great facilities to learn more about fitness and wellness. We continue to benefit from the generosity of so many of you in our most recent capital campaign that made our new facilities a reality.

We also continue to help our students pursue spiritual excellence through many activities including weekly Mass, which we continue to have for students on a rotational basis during the current school year. Opportunities continue for retreats, faith sharing, and service to our larger community. Helping our students understand the importance of being active members of their faith help us continue to form disciples today and saints for eternity.

Beckman Catholic, along with Xavier Elementary, is now in year two of our four-year strategic planning process with the Archdiocese of Dubuque and Catholic School Management, a national firm who assists Catholic schools across the United States with these efforts. We've made adjustments due to the pandemic, but continue to focus on plans including developing strategic initiatives, creating new communications and marketing plans, and strengthening our development programs. We are fortunate to have a strong foundation at Beckman Catholic due to the efforts so many of you have made and continue to make which will be of immense help as we develop these initiatives.

I am reminded that none of this would be possible without your continued support. This report highlights the generosity of so many individuals to make Catholic education possible in our area. We are extremely grateful for these gifts, as well as the gifts of time, talents, and prayers we receive. At this time of challenge, we are especially grateful for your continued generosity and support. Samuel Oberbroeckling Achieves Eagle Scout Rank

Samuel Oberbroeckling - BCHS of 2021 achieved the rank of Eagle Scout in October, 2020. He is a member of Boy Scout Troop 60, in Dyersville, and Order of the Arrow Timmeau Lodge 74. Sam coordinated a renovation of the pavilion at the trailhead of Heritage Trail in Dyersville as his Eagle project. The roof of the pavilion was reshingled and the entire pavilion repainted. In addition, the sign inside the pavilion was refurbished and a new, more current map of the trail was installed. Once he earned his 21 merit badges and was ready to take the next step with his Eagle project, the Heritage Trail pavilion was a natural choice. A total of 203 man-hours were donated, and the project was completed at a cost of \$1,395.74. Many people donated to help Sam complete this project. Sam began his scouting journey at age seven and credits his father, Mike, along with his grandfather, Tom Oberbroeckling, for

guiding him through his scouting career. Sam is a National Honor Society member, plays basketball, participated in cross country, soccer and disc golf and is the son of Mike and Sandy Oberbroeckling, and plans to continue his academic career at the University of Iowa to study engineering.








OPERATING EXPENSES
